Introducing the Kit Shrimper

As the builder, Cornish Crabbers will be supplying the kit for their most popular model. Our priority is to provide the same quality and safety standards expected of the standard Cornish Shrimper. Once your project is finished to our instructions, using only the materials supplied, you can count on us for the essential RCD certification giving you peace of mind that you have completed a successful build to recognised industry standards.

What do you get?

- You will receive a hull and deck (blue, green or cream options) with all structural work complete, including centre plate system, mast support post, hull and deck joined.
- If you have opted for an inboard Shrimper, the engine will also be fitted as standard.
- You will also receive a pack of all materials required to complete a standard Shrimper (excluding glue and paint).
- Your Kit Shrimper will also include a set of instructions and declaration forms, these will need to be completed and approved by us so that you can receive your RCD compliance.
- You can also opt to receive a finishing pack. This contains items required to complete the build, but can be sourced elsewhere if required. For details, see overleaf.

Finishing Kit

In the optional finishing kit you can expect the following:

Sails – Main, jib and boom cover.

Cushions – Either Cotton / linen or wipe clean waterproof in a range of colours.

Gas Burner – Stainless steel gimble basket with single camping gaz burner and bottle.

Water Bottle – Plastic jerry can with pump

Bucket – The Shrimper sink...

What do you need to do?

Whether you have the boat building bug, or you're experimenting with the kit format, this brief outline should give you an idea of the exciting steps you'll be taking to build your Shrimper.

- 1) The Hull and Deck are joined ready for you to fit all the external fittings and trims. You will only need simple 'off the shelf' tools to do the jobs required. Any tricky jobs requiring specialist tools will be done for you.



2) Interior fixtures.

Inside the boat is structurally complete with the mast support post fitted and the centreplate system complete and tested. You are presented with a bare interior moulding that requires all the pre fabricated woodwork fitting to it. This will require basic skills using a mix of glue, screws and a little bit of trimming. All the wood work will also need painting.



3) The Rig.

All the wooden spars are delivered with one coat of Sikkens treatment. You will need to apply the 2 top coats and fit all the fittings as supplied. All the running and standing rigging is also supplied. We ship the spars on top of the boat secure to the Tabernacle and Mainsheet track which are both fitted for you in the factory.
